Rekha Mittal, J.

The claimant is in appeal seeking enhancement of compensation in respect of injuries sustained by him in a motor vehicular accident that took place on 16.7.2002.

The Motor Accidents Claims Tribunal, Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhri (in short “the Tribunal”) has awarded compensation of Rs. 2,40,000/-, payable with interest @ 9% per annum from the date of petition till realization.

Perusal of findings of the Tribunal recorded in para 18 of the award would manifest that the Tribunal has shown magnanimity in awarding compensation particularly loss of income with regard to disability to the extent of 8%. In this view of the matter, there is no justification for allowing compensation more than what has been awarded by the Tribunal.

In view of what has been discussed hereinabove, finding no

merit, the appeal fails and is accordingly dismissed, leaving the parties to bear their own costs.
