Grievance of the petitioner is that strict action be taken against the owners of the tractor-trolleys/trucks which are being overloaded while transporting foodgrains. It is the submission made by counsel that there are norms fixed under the Motor Vehicles Act, as regards maximum load to be carried in respect of different classes of transport vehicles.

Having heard counsel for the petitioner at length and without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the writ petition in terms of granting liberty to bring the matter to the notice of the concerned Regional Transport Authority.

Needless to observe that as and when the petitioner approaches the authority concerned, the matter would be looked into and remedial steps as warranted in accordance with law, would be taken.
