This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of appropriate direction to respondents No.1 to 4 for taking legal action as per law by constituting a Special Investigation Team to probe into the death of the husband of the petitioner.

It is stated that the husband of the petitioner was working at the IOCL, Refinery, Panipat as Senior Manager and was residing in the Guest House in the campus. On 04.01.2019 the petitioner received a call that her husband had fallen while getting down from the car and was being taken to the Refinery Hospital. The petitioner's son reached Panipat at about 12.30 PM and found that his father had been shifted to another hospital and was on ventilator. The patient was shifted to Delhi and, in Delhi from one

hospital to another but he ultimately passed away on 05.01.2019. As per the autopsy report he had '*cranio-cerebral damage consequent to blunt force impact to the head*'. As per the petitioner it is her suspicion that this injury was deliberately caused and she prays that despite the lapse of 5 months even an FIR has not been lodged in this regard.

Keeping in view the entire facts and without commenting on the merits of the case, in my opinion, it is not a fit case for exercise of the extra ordinary jurisdiction under Section 482 Cr.P.C. and consequently, this petition is dismissed with liberty to the petitioner to avail other remedies as per law.

Petition stands dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
