The petitioner has come up in writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent No.2 to follow the order dated 12.12.2017 passed in CWP No.24190 of 2017 and connected matters and order dated 01.09.2017 passed in CWP No.17899 of 2017 and connected matters (Annexure P-1 colly) and take any decision upon representation dated 12.01.2018 (Annexure P-2).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that vide orders passed on 12.12.2017 and 01.09.2017 (Annexure P-1 colly), respondents were directed to examine the cases of the employees as per the policy dated 06.10.2004 and as per directions given by this Court. The petitioner is aggrieved because his case has not been considered in view of the orders (Annexure P-1 colly). As such, he has filed representation dated 12.01.2018 (Annexure P-2) but no action has been taken in this regard. Ultimately he has filed contempt petition i.e. COCP No. 1406 of 2018 (Annexure P-3) but the same was disposed of with liberty to raise the dispute in the writ petition.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is allowed and

directions are being given to respondents No. 2 to 5 look into the representation (Annexure P-2) and decide the same within one month in view of the guidelines passed in the writ petitions vide order dated 12.12.2017 and 01.09.2017 (Annexure P-1 colly).
