The instant petition has been filed by Amar Pati raising an innocuous prayer for the respondents to take a decision on a representation dated 18.1.2019 (Annexure P-1) that is stated to have been submitted.

Counsel for the petitioner has been heard and pleadings on record have been perused.

The representation at Annexure P-1 would reveal that husband of the petitioner is working as a Postman under the postal authorities and the wife i.e. the present petitioner is raising a grievance that he has been called upon to discharge duties arbitrarily at a distance of 30 kms away from village Sayana and at village Rasulpur.

Counsel would attempt to impress upon this Court that the respondent authorities lack jurisdiction and power to have transferred husband of the petitioner at village Rasulpur.

In the considered view of this Court, the instant petition is wholly misconceived.

If husband of the petitioner has any grievance with regard to his posting while working under the postal authorities, he can agitate the matter if so advised and by approaching the concerned forum/authority.

No intervention in the instant writ petition is warranted.

Petition is dismissed.
