The controversy in the present litigation is with regard to the scooter market being run at Gill Road, Ludhiana.

In pursuance to order dated 01.10.2019, Ms. Kanwal Preet Brar, Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana is present in Court today and states that there is a long drawn litigation. Certain members of the petitioners' association are owners of shop at Gill Road. They were carrying the business of sale and purchase of old and new scooters at Gill Road. As there was a litigation going on in this Court for stopping said market, the people who were carrying business at Gill Road were allotted alternative sites to carry on of their business of re-sale and purchase of the scooters. She submits that in spite of specific directions of this Court and the best efforts made by the respondent-Department, certain new people and the persons who had been already allotted alternative sites have tendency to re-start the business of sale and purchase of scooters at Gill Road. She

assures that strict actions in accordance with the law would be taken against the violators and if need be, she will ask for police help for doing the needful.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the statement made in Court today, he does not want to press the present contempt proceedings.

The contempt petition is disposed of.

Rule issued against the respondent is discharged.
