AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 28.01.2019 passed by this Court in CWP No.2234 of 2019.

Learned counsel for the respondent has produced order dated 16.07.2019 whereby representation dated 22.07.2018 and 23.09.2018 of the petitioner have been decided, same is taken on record. Copy of order is handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of order passed, learned counsel for the petitioner states that no cause of action survives for pursuing the contempt

petition. However, he seeks liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law against the order passed.

The contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.
