The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in Criminal Complaint No.43 dated 04.02.2016 titled as '*Karnail Chand vs Paramjit Kaur and others*' filed under Sections 504, 506 IPC and 3(i)(x) of the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989.

On 16.05.2019, the following order was passed:

“Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is an old lady aged about 74 years and she is summoned in a complaint case filed by the respondent/complainant by the trial Court vide order dated 19.04.2019. It is further argued that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial Court and apply for bail. Notice of motion for 29.05.2019.

In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the trial Court within a period of 01 week from today and the trial Court will release the

**petitioner on interim bail subject to her furnishing
bail/surety bonds to its satisfaction.”**

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 16.05.2019, has already appeared before the trial Court and she has been released on interim bail. A copy of the order dated 20.05.2019, passed by the trial Court granting interim bail to the petitioner, is also placed on record.

Learned counsel for the State has not disputed the factual position.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the order dated 16.05.2019 is made absolute.
