The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.394, dated 4.5.2019, registered under Sections 16, 17, 17-A, 17-B, 18, 18-A, 18(a)(I), 18(a)(vi), 18(b), 18(c), 22(I)(cca) and 36-AC of Drugs and Cosmetics Act and Section 420 of the IPC, at Police Station City Karnal.

After arguing for some time, counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw this petition but states that the petitioner will surrender before the trial Court and a direction be issued to decide his application for regular bail within a reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request. Consequently, this petition is dismissed as withdrawn. In case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court on 27.5.2019 and moves an application for regular bail, the same be

decided in accordance with law expeditiously but in any case on or before
29.5.2019

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.Ms, if
any, also stand disposed of.
