Pursuant to the order of this Court (coordinate Bench), dated 16.05.2019, the petitioner Ravindra Kumar, as also the complainant, i.e. respondent no.2 herein, Ranpreet Kaur, are present in Court, with the former having produced his original Aadhar Card, with him also identified by his counsel and the latter having produced her original Voter Identity Card, she also being identified by her counsel.

Upon query to respondent no.2 (complainant in the FIR), she has categorically stated that she has compromised the matter with the petitioner of her own free will, with no pressure or coercion.

That being so, there is no ground for this Court to doubt that statement, considering also the manner in which it has been said.

Consequently, the petition is allowed and FIR No.0018 of 2019, registered against the petitioner at Police Station NIT, Faridabad, for

the alleged commission of an offence punishable under Section 354A of the
IPC, along with all proceedings emanating therefrom, is hereby quashed.
