Mr. Satpal, Assistant Passport Officer, Jalandhar is present in Court. He states that passport could not be issued as there is an adverse verification report. He further states that father's name of the petitioner would be changed as per the decree of the Civil Court but Passport Office reserves its right to proceed in accordance with law, if need so arises. Still further, he states that in case there is no impediment in issuing the passport with changed father's name, the same would be done expeditiously and in case it is not to be issued, the Passport Office will communicate reasons to the petitioner.
