MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioners have sought anticipatory bail in FIR No.166 dated 15.09.2018 registered under Section 306 of Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Chamkaur Sahib, District Rupnagar.

On 30.10.2018, this Court had passed the following order:-

“It has been submitted that the petitioners were the mediator and the relative of the father-in-law of the deceased.

Notice of motion for 05.02.2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioners are directed to surrender before the Arresting/Investigating Officer within seven days. On doing so, they shall be released on interim bail, subject to their furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, they shall abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged

under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. failing which they shall loose the benefit of interim bail allowed to them.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that in pursuance of the order dated 30.10.2018, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Manpreet Kaur submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 30.10.2018, is made absolute.

The petition stands allowed.
