Heard.

This is a petition for quashing of the FIR No. 47 dated 15.3.2016, under Sections 448, 380, 427, 506, 511, 34 of the Indian Penal Code (Annexure P-1), registered at Police Station Salem Tabri, Ludhiana along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

Vide order dated 30.10.2018, both parties were directed to get their statements recorded before the trial Court and learned Magistrate was directed to submit its report.

Learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana, vide its letter dated 4.12.2018 has reported that statement of both the parties have been recorded that they have arrived at a compromise which is genuine, without any pressure and coercion.

Since the matter has been compromised and the trial of the case will be useless exercise, FIR No. 47 dated 15.3.2016, under Sections 448, 380, 427, 506, 511, 34 of the Indian Penal Code (Annexure P-1), registered at Police Station Salem Tabri, Ludhiana along with consequential proceedings qua petitioners stand quashed.

Petition stands allowed.
