This is the 2nd petition filed by the petitioner under Section 439 of the Cr.P.C., the 1st one having been dismissed as withdrawn on 11.10.2018.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from the police official who is present in Court today to assist him, submits that the trial is at its concluding stages, with only two prosecution witnesses left to be examined, one of them being a police official, the next date of hearing being 30.07.2019.

Consequently, while dismissing this petition at this stage, the trial Court is directed to try and ensure that the trial is concluded within a period of three months from today, with the SSP, Moga, also directed to ensure that the remaining witness from the Police Department positively appears to testify on the date that the trial Court summons him to do so.
