The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. to direct respondent No.1 to issue direction to respondent no.2 that he should look into the matter and ask respondent No. 3 to take appropriate action against respondent No.4.

Learned State counsel has filed the status report by way of an affidavit of Dr. Arun Singh, IPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, Sirsa in the Court. The same is taken on record. A copy thereof has been supplied to the opposite side.

In pursuance of the previous order dated 16.01.2019, the Superintendent of Police, Sirsa is present in the Court and has apprised that respondent No.4 has been arrested in the FIR No. 822 dated 17.10.2017, under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Sirsa

City, District Sirsa and as on today he is in custody.

Since respondent No.4 has already been arrested, therefore, the grievance of the petitioner is redressed. No further directions are required to be issued in the matter and the present petition is disposed of as such.

Needless to say that investigation in the matter shall be completed expeditiously.
