The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.260 dated 19.9.2018 under Sections 307, 427, 148, 149 IPC, and under Section 25/27 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Talwandi Sabo, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the FIR in the present case is the outcome of sudden fight and no injury has been caused to anyone.

A Coordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated 22.11.2018, had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the

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Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Krishan Singh, states that the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners and keeping in view the fact that the petitioners have joined investigation, the order dated 22.11.2018 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute. However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so. The petition stands disposed of.
