Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.196 dated 29.08.2018 (P-1), under Sections 420 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station City Faridkot, Distt. Faridkot.

This Court, while issuing notice of motion on 30.10.2018, passed the following order:-

“ It is contended by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the complainant had gone to Cyprus to work as labourer and he worked there for almost 6 months and got his visa extended upto 2025 and no offence is made out against the petitioner.

Notice of motion for 14.01.2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of his arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit him to interim bail till the next date of hearing on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

Today, ASI Gurdit Singh, Police Station City Faridkot, District Faridkot submits that petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of order dated 30.10.2018 and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

In view of above, interim order dated 30.10.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the present petition stands disposed off.

It is made clear that the petitioner shall fully co-operate with the Investigating Officer as and when called for further investigation.

The observations may not be considered as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
