The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 175 dated 20.04.2019, under Sections 420, 406 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station City Tohana , District Fatehabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that she had taken a sum of ₹2,30,000/- from the complainant to send her daughter abroad. He also contends that the daughter of the complainant was sent to Malaysia and returned back after staying there for about a week. He further contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated as the daughter of the petitioner had also gone to Malaysia along with the daughter of the complainant and she is still residing there. He further contends that the petitioner is not involved in any other case.

This Court, by the order dated 20.08.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of her arrest, she was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail

to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Pawan Kumar, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 20.08.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. She shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
