In the present writ petition, the grievance of the petitioners is that though the petitioners were asked to discharge the duties of the post of Sub-Divisional Engineer even while working substantively on the post of Junior Engineer, petitioners have become entitled for the grant of the pay of the post of Sub-Divisional Engineer keeping in view the provisions of Rule 4.4. (2) (c) (i) of the Punjab Civil Services Rules, Vol.I, Part-I.

Learned counsel for the petitioners supports the arguments by relying on the order passed by this Court in CWP No.3922 of 2011 titled as Narender Pal Singh Arya and another vs. State of Haryana and others.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that for the relief which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioners have submitted a representation dated 01.10.2018 (Annexure P-2) to the respondents and the petitioners will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioners for the relief which has been claimed by them in the representation dated 01.10.2018 (Annexure P-2), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the representation dated 01.10.2018 (Annexure P-2) within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, it is found that the petitioners are entitled for any monetary benefits after the decision of the representation, the same should also be paid to them within three months thereafter.
