Report dated 14.11.2018 of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Ambala has been received whereby after recording statements of respondent No.2-Megha Gandhi and accused/petitioners, namely, Gaurav Gandhi, Satish Kumar Gandhi and Reeta Gandhi @ Reeta Rani, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise has been arrived at voluntarily, out of their own free will, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Moreover, during the course hearing learned counsel for both the sides stated that parties have compromised the matter and shall abide by the same.

Heard.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court and the fact that the dispute between the parties being a pure matrimonial and the offence for which the accused have been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another**' 2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and '**Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another**' 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No. 111 dated 30.04.2014 registered at Police Station Parao, Ambala Cantt under Sections 406/498-A/323/506/34 of the IPC, and all consequences arising out of the said FIR qua the petitioners are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
