The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0074 dated 26.9.2018 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 406, 498-A of Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Women Cell, District Chandigarh.

Heard.

A settlement has been arrived between the parties at the Mediation & Conciliation Centre of this Court vide report of the Mediator dated 17.12.2018. Its copy is taken on record.

Learned State counsel has informed that now a petition under Section 13-B of Hindu Marriage Act has been filed.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the order dated 30.10.2018 is made absolute till the

- (i) that the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation as and when required by the police;
- (ii) that the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the accusation against him so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- (iii) that the petitioner shall not leave India without the prior permission of the trial Court.
- (iv) that the petitioner will seek regular bail on the presentation of challan in Court.
