This is the second petition filed by the petitioner seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.55 dated 21.05.2018 under Sections 363, 366, 376, 378 and 120 IPC as well as Section 6 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 registered at Police Station Mamdot, District Ferozepur.

At this stage, Mr. Karanjeet Singh Brar, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant and states that after registration of the FIR, the petitioner had approached this Court for grant of anticipatory bail and vide order dated 31.01.2019, this Court had dismissed the said petition. He further states that during pendency of the present FIR, the petitioner has been declared as a proclaimed offender.

Power of attorney filed on behalf of the complainant in Court today, is taken on record.

Taking into consideration the statement so made by learned counsel for the complainant, this Court finds that since the petitioner has been declared as a proclaimed offence, the present petition seeking anticipatory bail is not maintainable and the same is, accordingly, dismissed.

However, in case the statement made by learned counsel for the complainant is found to be incorrect, the petitioner shall be at liberty to revive this petition which shall be considered in accordance with law.
