This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for issuance of direction to respondent No.4 to act on the letter dated 21.1.2019 (Annexure P-3) and deposit the proportionate share (31:69) of the income from the 'shamlat deh' land pertaining to village Chhappra Khera and also to restrain the respondents from holding the auction schedule to be held on 16.5.2019 vide Notification dated 29.4.2019 of village Chhappra Jagir, which includes the share of the land of village Chhppra Khera and direct them to hold the auction for the villages Chhppra Jagir and Chhappra Khera separately.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage, he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 - Deputy Commissioner, Karnal to consider and decide the representation dated 12.3.2018 (Annexure P-2) expeditiously in the light of office memo dated 31.3.2016 (Annexure P-1).

Heard.

A complete set of paper book has been handed over to Mr.Vikrant Pamboo, DAG, Haryana in the Court today.

In view of the above, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 - Deputy Commissioner, Karnal to consider and decide the representation dated 12.3.2018 (Annexure P-2) in the light of office memo dated 31.3.2016 (Annexure P-1) in accordance with law within six weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the judgment.

In the circumstances, the respondent No.2 is directed not to utilize the amount of auction proceeds till the decision of the representation dated 12.3.2018 (Annexure P-2).
