In the present writ petition, the claim which is being raised by the petitioner is that his father, who was working with the respondent-Haryana State Electricity Board, unfortunately, died on 15.11.1981 and no benefit after his death has been released to his family and even the mother of the petitioner, unfortunately, passed away on 29.11.1996.

The present writ petition has been filed seeking the release of the pensionary benefits including Provident Fund, which was deposited during the service period when Sh. Chamel Singh alias Chamela Ram i.e. father of the petitioner worked with the respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief, which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has made representation dated 03.05.2019 (Annexure P-7) to the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied in case a time bound direction is given to the

respondents to decide the representation by passing a speaking order.

Without going into the merits of the case or expressing any opinion to the entitlement of the petitioner in respect of the claim prayed in the present writ petition or in the representation, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to pass an appropriate speaking order on the claim raised by the petitioner in the representation dated 03.05.2019 (Annexure P-7) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
