ANIL KSHETARPAL, J.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the alleged recovery from the petitioner is 5 gms heroine and 770 tablets (100.34 gms) of Alprazolam. He further submits that recovery of 5 gms heroine falls in small quantity, whereas with regard to recovery of 770 tablets of Alprazolam, the quantity is marginally higher than the commercial quantity. He also submits that the investigation is complete and challan has been presented.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the State submits that as per custody certificate, the petitioner is also involved in another case under NDPS. However, on instructions from HC Sukhdev Singh, he submits that in latter case, the recovery is 2 gms heroine, which is again small quantity and petitioner is on bail in the said case.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the aforesaid facts as also the trial of the case is likely to take time, it is considered appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail on her furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Moga.

Petition stands disposed of.
