This petition was filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.69 dated 04.3.2014, under Sections 406 and 420 IPC, registered at Police Station City, Kaputahala.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed that after completion of investigation, the final report was submitted and the trial Court after taking formal cognizance of the offences, proceeded with the trial and as per Mr. Soi, learned counsel for the petitioner, 3-4 witnesses have been examined by the prosecution.

Since the trial is in progress and the accused/petitioner has participated in the trial, this Court does not find it appropriate to exercise the inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR in question.
