On 27.09.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that offences under Sections 379B and 326 IPC have been added by the prosecuting agency.

Learned counsel for the petitioners points out that the prayer for pre-arrest bail qua petitioner Nos.1 and 2 has become infructuous as they have been released on regular bail.

Learned counsel for the petitioners relied upon the order dated 25.09.2019 passed by this Court in the case of co-accused bearing CRM-M No.41289 of 2019, titled as "Vijay Gharu and another vs State of Punjab".

Adjourned to 20.11.2019.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner Nos.3 and 4 shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal

bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, they shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Niranjn Singh, has submitted that petitioner Nos.3 and 4 have joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view thereof, order dated 27.09.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
