Present petition has been filed seeking quashing of the speaking order dated 17.04.2019 passed by respondent No.3 (Superintendent of Police, Kaithal) and directing the official respondents to register a FIR against the respondents No.5 to 12.

This Court has already held in another petition i.e. CRM-M-20457-2019 decided on 06.05.2019 that unless the statutory proceedings have already been initiated by a statutory authority or Court under Code of Criminal Procedure(for short, 'Cr.P.C'), the petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C is not maintainable for issuance of any direction. The remedy is a writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as not maintainable.
