Heard.

It is alleged that petitioner was given some injuries on 17.3.2017 by private respondents. Petitioner approached Punjab State Women Commission, Chandigarh, and on the directions of Punjab State Women Commission, Chandigarh, an inquiry was conducted by AIG, Administration, Bureau of Investigation, Punjab, and report (Annexure-P-2) was submitted. However, Director, Bureau of Investigation, Punjab, Chandigarh, vide report (Annexure-P-4) took view that no case can be registered without MLR.

The facts of case show that infact petitioner wants to register FIR against private respondents regarding incident, regarding which there is no MLR and there is only treatment report of private hospital

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dated 27.3.2017. Petitioner is relegated to avail appropriate remedy
before learned Illaqa Magistrate.

Petition is accordingly disposed of.
