Learned State counsel on instructions from
ASIManjinder Singh, Police Station Division No.4, Jalandhar
submits that in consequence of interim order dated 16.05.2019,
the petitioner has since joined the investigation but the
Investigating Agency is unable to recover the articles of
entrustment so alleged by the complainant side. The complainant
has also stoutly opposed the grant of bail.

However, in the light of the statement made by the

learned State counsel and that culpability if any will be determined at the trial, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 16.05.2019 is made absolute till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

With these observations, the present petition stands disposed off.
