Petitioners who are two in number are stated to be minors and both are daughters of Sh. Manoj Lakhanpal and through whom the instant writ petition has been filed.

A writ of mandamus is sought for directing the official respondents under the State of Punjab to release financial assistance as per scheme formulated by the State called the ***“Female Child Protection Scheme”***.

Counsel would submit that the petitioners are eligible for the financial assistance under the afore-noticed scheme and the respondents authorities without any justifiable basis have with-held the benefit.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sahil Sharma, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 5 and waives service. A complete copy of the writ paper-book already stands furnished.

Statement of learned State counsel is recorded to the effect

that in case an application seeking financial assistance under the ***Female Child Protection Scheme***, is pending, the same would be processed expeditiously as per terms and conditions of the Scheme itself and a final decision would be conveyed to the petitioner.

In the light of such statement no further directions are required to be passed.
