Prayer in the petition is to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.635 dated 04.09.2018 registered under Sections 457, 380 of IPC, at Police Station Camp Palwal, District Palwal.

Learned counsel for the State on instructions from ASI Chandan Singh has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation and recovery of the stolen articles has already been made from the co-accused and the petitioner is not required for further custodial interrogation. However, he submits that the petitioner is a habitual offender as there are 5 such cases against the petitioner.

On being asked, learned counsel for the State frankly admitted that in all these cases, the petitioner is on bail and the trial in all these cases is pending.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, the order dated 16.05.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
