Petitioners before this Court have prayed for issuance of directions to respondents no.2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty as provided under Article 21 of the Constitution of India. Petitioners do not claim to be married. Petitioner no.1 is barely 18 years old as her date of birth as per Annexure P-1 is 25.04.2001.

A Coordinate Bench of this Court in the order passed in **Raj Rani and others vs. State of Punjab and others** (CRM-M-20457-2019, decided on 06.05.2019) has held that the petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is not maintainable.

Accordingly, petitioners are relegated to the remedy available under law.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
