This is first petition filed under Section 439 of Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner during pending trial of case FIR No.51 dated 09.07.2016 under Sections 399/402 IPC,1860 further added Section 25 of Arms Act,1959 registered at Police Station Mehta, District Amritsar Rural.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Baldev Singh, states that only 6 prosecution witnesses have been examined and the matter is listed on 29.05.2019 for examination of remaining prosecution witnesses and efforts shall be made to produce the remaining witnesses on the next date of hearing.

In view of the statement of the State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the

petition at this stage and the trial Court may be directed to conclude the trial expeditiously.

Dismissed as withdrawn at this stage. As the FIR was of the year 2016, therefore, the trial Court is directed to conclude the trial expeditiously preferably within a period of 6 months.
