GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner has approached this Court seeking issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to ensure protection from false implication in some criminal case and also to protect his life and liberty and also of other members of his family on account of involvement of petitioner's sons namely Major Singh and Vijay Singh in FIR No.42 dated 22.3.2019 under Sections 307, 506, 148, 149, 120-B and Section 25 of Arms Act, Police Station Goindwal Sahib.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that his sons Major Singh and Vijay Singh have been falsely implicated in FIR

No.42 dated 22.3.2019 under Sections 307, 506, 148, 149, 120-B and Section 25 of Arms Act, Police Station Goindwal Sahib and that police is now unnecessarily harassing and pressuring the petitioner to produce his sons although he is not aware about their whereabouts at the moment.

3. Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran to ensure that in case, the petitioner is required to be associated with any inquiry or investigation or some information is to be elicited from him, then a written advance notice in terms of Section 160 of Criminal Procedure Code, 1973 be served upon him.
4. A copy of this order along be sent to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
