“It is therefore respectfully prayed that present petition may kindly be allowed and issued the directions to respondents No.1 to 4 to issue notice of 7 days under Section 160 Cr.P.C. to the petitioners as and when they are required for investigation in the present case (Annexure P-4) as no FIR is pending against them.”

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Rajpal Singh, has submitted that the petitioners are involved in a case of cheating and fraud of huge amount. Investigating Agency has almost completed its investigation and involvement of one Manager of Gramin Bank has also been found.

In view of the aforesaid statement, the present petition is disposed of as this Court does not find that the petitioners are entitled to any relief under Section 482 Cr.P.C. which is inherent power of the Court.
