I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioner was released on parole on 18.9.2018 for 42 days. She was to surrender on 1.11.2018. The petitioner claims that she could not surrender due to medical emergency as she was advised rest. Now she has moved to this Court in May 2019 after more than 6 months, for extension of parole for 6 months. The petitioner was convicted and sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for a period of ten years under Section 18 of the NDPS Act.

Since the parole of the petitioner has already expired on 1.11.2018 and she has not complied with the condition of parole, it cannot be extended.

Dismissed.

Petitioner is directed to immediately surrender before Jail authorities.
