Present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been filed for issuance of directions to the official respondents to arrest the accused and complete the investigation in FIR No.27 dated 20.01.2018, under Sections 323, 379-A, 427, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Ferozepur Jhirka.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that although Cancellation Report was accepted by learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Ferozepur Jhirka, vide order dated 11.01.2019, but there was no proper intimation to the petitioner/complainant as she is alleged to have been served through her family member.

Be that as it may, the Cancellation Report has been accepted by learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Ferozepur Jhirka, vide order dated 11.01.2019 and if the petitioner/complainant is aggrieved against such acceptance, she is at liberty to challenge the same in accordance with law and can also raise the plea of improper notice sent to her.

In view of above, no further directions are required to be issued in the present case.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed off.
