In view of resolution of the Bar, the lawyers are abstaining from work.

Prayer in this petition is for issuance of a direction to the respondents for conducting fair investigation in FIR No.125 dated 02.05.2017 under Sections 323, 324, 34, 427, 506 IPC and Sections 452, 454, 380 IPC (added later on), Police Station Nissing, District Karnal.

Reply by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Assandh, District Karnal is on record. As per this affidavit, during the investigation, on 02.05.2017, Sections 452, 454, 380 IPC were added and thereafter, accused Gurmeet Kaur, Amrik Singh, Gurpreet Singh, Kulwant Singh and Ranjit Singh were joined the investigation and they were formally arrested in compliance of the order dated 11.12.2017 passed in CRM-M-21332-2017 and CRM-M-21527-2017. At the time of presentation of final investigation report under Section 173 (2) Cr.P.C. before the trial Court on

18.05.2018, Section 452 IPC was deleted and thereafter, the trial Court has already framed the charges on 25.07.2018 under Sections 323, 324, 427, 454, 506, 34 IPC and the case is now fixed on 20.09.2019 for recording the prosecution evidence.

In view of the above, no further action is called for, in the present petition. However, the petitioner as well as complainant are granted liberty to approach the trial Court for redressal of their grievance, if any.

Disposed of, accordingly.
