Petitioners herein who claim to have attained the age of majority are stated to be living together, even though not married.

Counsel submits that both the petitioners are apprehending a threat to the life and liberty at the hands of the private respondents No.4 to 6.

Having heard counsel for the petitioners and having perused the pleadings on record and without opining on the relationship between the parties, writ petition is disposed of in terms of granting liberty to the petitioners to approach the Superintendent of Police, District Hisar, as regards their threat perception which has been voiced in the instant writ petition.

In the eventuality of any application being moved by the petitioners, respondent No.2 i.e. Superintendent of Police, District Hisar, would be obligated to look into the matter and to thereafter take steps as he may deem fit and warranted in accordance with law.
