Present petition has been filed praying for protection to the life and liberty of the petitioners, in view of the marriage solemnized by them against the wishes of respondent No. 4.

In pursuance of the order dated 06.12.2018, both the petitioners are present in the Court.

It has been pointed out by learned counsel for respondent No.4 that Rajinder Kumar-respondent No.4 is present in Court and he has no objection against the marriage solemnized by his daughter with petitioner No.2. Respondent No.4 has also acknowledged that the daughter is living peacefully and there is no need to deposit an amount of Rs. 3 lacs in her favour by petitioner No.2 in terms of the order dated 31.10.2018.

In view of the stand taken by respondent No.4, the order

dated 31.10.2018 is modified accordingly. As a result thereof, no further directions are required to be issued in the matter and is disposed off as such.
