This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.60 dated 24.2.2018 registered under Sections 302, 201, 34 IPC at police station Narwana, District Jind.

Custody certificate dated 21.5.2019 by way of affidavit of Rakesh Kumar-Dsp, Deputy Superintendent, District Prison (Jind)-Haryana has been filed on behalf of the respondent-State, the same is taken on record. Copy has been supplied to the opposite counsel. As per the custody certificate the petitioner has been in custody for 1 year 2 months and 6 days.

Learned AAG on instructions from Investigating Officer states that in this FIR co-accused Arun Kumar has filed bail petition bearing **CRM-M-4428-2019** and this Court vide order 5.3.2019 ordered that in case

the prosecution fails to conclude its entire evidence on or before 12.7.2019 the co-accused will be released on bail. The present petitioner is on the same footing as co-accused Arun Kumar.

In these circumstances, the present bail petition stands disposed of in the same terms as in **CRM-M-4428-2019**.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
