The present contempt petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of the order dated 01.11.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No. 28077 of 2018. The operative part of the order is reproduced below:

“Accordingly, present writ petition stands disposed of with the directions to respondent No.2 to consider and decide legal notice dated 05.07.2018 (Annexure P7) expeditiously and preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.”

A reply by way of affidavit of Sh. L.N. Dua, Chief Engineer, HPGCL, DCRTTP, Yamunanagar, filed in Court today, is taken on record. A copy of the same is handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the reply filed in Court today, no cause of action survives for pursuing the

contempt petition. However, he seeks liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law.

Disposed of with liberty as prayed for.

Rule issued against the respondent is discharged.
