The petitioners have preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.111 dated 25.09.2018, registered under Sections 363, 366-A, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Cantt Bathinda, District Bathinda.

Learned State counsel has stated that the petitioners have joined the investigation; nothing is to be recovered from them and they are no more required for custodial interrogation. Apart from it, both petitioners and prosecutrix had filed the petition for protection bearing CRM-M No.46862-2018 decided on 23.10.2018.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in the present case. Ordered accordingly.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 01.11.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
