Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.70 dated 15.05.2016 under Sections 354, 323 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Fazilka, District Fazilka.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has produced an order dated 17.11.2018 passed by JMIC, Fazilka and submits that he has appeared before the trial Court and moved an application for acceptance of bail bonds and surety bonds in terms of order dated 01.11.2018 passed by this Court and accordingly, he has been admitted on interim bail.

Learned State counsel does not dispute the submissions made on behalf of the petitioner.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 01.11.2018 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall appear before the trial Court as and when called for, unless he is granted exemption from personal appearance.
