Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.186 dated 10.12.2016 under Sections 304-B/120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Harsa Singh, submits that out of total 16 witnesses cited by the prosecution, 07 witnesses have been examined in the case and the remaining witnesses are mostly formal in nature.

Faced with the situation, learned counse for the petitioner does not press the present petition. However, she prays that considering the custody of the petitioner, the trial Court be directed to expedite the trial.

The prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner carries weight. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed as not pressed. However, the trial Court shall make an endeavour to conclude the trial expeditiously preferably within a period of three months from today.
