The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the order dated 13.12.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No. 30462 of 2018. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“Learned State counsel submits that in the eventuality, the application of the petitioner is pending with the authorities, it shall take a decision thereon expeditiously, in any case, not later than two months.

In view of above, Mr. Randhawa submits that he may be allowed to withdraw the petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.”

Reply dated 27.8.2019 by way of affidavit of Shivdular Singh Dhillon, Deputy Commissioner, Amritsar was filed annexing order

21.12.2018 rejecting the renewal application of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the order passed, no cause of action survives for pursuing the contempt petition. However, he seeks liberty to avail remedies available in accordance with law against the order passed.

Disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.
