Petitioner Harman Singh has preferred the instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.05 dated 27.02.2018, registered under Sections 365, 384, 506, 120-B IPC, Section 4 of the Protection of children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 and Section 67-A of the Information and Technology Act, 2000, at Police Station Women, Yamuna Nagar, District Yamuna Nagar.

The allegation against the petitioner is that he had committed rape upon the minor prosecutrix in a forcible and deceitful manner.

The record transpires that the trial is in progress.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the seriousness of the offence, this court is of the opinion that the petitioner is not entitled to grant the concession of regular bail to him.

Consequently, the instant petition stands dismissed.
