Learned counsel for the petitioners states that after the matter having been compromised between the parties and respondent No.2 has received a sum of Rs.5 lakh from the petitioners and now she is not coming forward to depose in terms of the compromise. He further states that it is on the basis of compromise so settled between the parties, decree of divorce under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 was passed by learned District Judge, Jalandhar on 29.01.2016.

Since respondent No.2 is not coming forward to depose in the case and the present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise, at this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks withdrawal of the present petition, so as to file a fresh petition for quashing of FIR on merit.
