AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

These two contempt petitions have been filed pleading wilful disobedience of orders dated 26.10.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No.22923 of 2018 and No.22837 of 2018. Since the facts involved in both the contempt petitions are similar, these are being disposed of by a common order. For convenience, facts are being taken from COCP No.1840 of 2019.

The respondents have filed reply dated 20.08.2019

annexing three vouchers making certain payments.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that entire payment has not been made, he disputes the amount due as arrived at by the respondents.

The directions of this Court were to take decision on the representation but no specific order has been passed on the representation.

Let needful be done within eight weeks from today, after affording opportunity of hearing to the petitioner. The petitioner shall appear before the respondent (in COCP No.1840 of 2019) on 18.09.2019 and respondent (in COCP No.1841 of 2019) on 19.09.2019 at 11:00 A.M. in their offices.

Needless to say that in case grievance still survives against the order passed by the respondents, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law.

The contempt petitions are disposed of, with liberty aforesaid.
